Join Online, \$80 for the first adult membership, \$70 for the second (18 yrs +), HST extra. Memberships for under 18 years are free with the purchase of an adult membership.

Your membership will provide you with access to other trail systems outside of the Forest as well, just like with the snowmobile clubs.

The local ATV club is part of the Eastern Ontario Trails Alliance (www.thetrail.ca) which has trails from Lake St. Peter to Ottawa, south to Kingston and back to Trent Hills in Northumberland County.

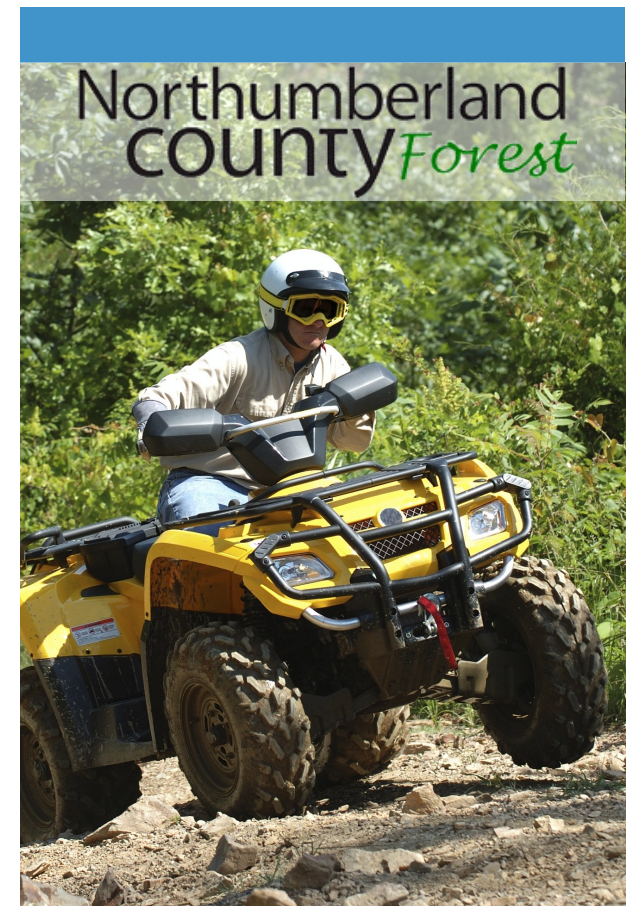

Important Trail Information
for Off Road Vehicles

What you need to know:

- All motorized use is CLOSED between April 1 and May 15 (for spring thaw and breeding birds)
- A portion of trail in Central Forest is multi use for motorized and non motorized uses
- Highway Traffic Act & Off Road Vehicles Act apply– driver's license, insurance & ownership (i.e.16 years & older)
