
**CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT
BIG APPLE DRIVE (COUNTY ROAD No. 25)
NOTICE OF STUDY COMMENCEMENT**

Northumberland County, through their consultant McCormick Rankin Corporation, has initiated a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment for Big Apple Drive (County Road No. 25) from Highway 401 to Kelwood Lane. The purpose of this study is to complete the planning required under the Class Environmental Assessment (EA) process to permit the County to proceed with the Reconstruction of Big Apple Drive. The planning will include the consideration of a centre turn lane to improve traffic flows to accommodate recent development.

The study is being planned under Schedule 'B' of the Municipal Class EA. As part of the study, a Public Consultation Centre will be held later this year. The Consultation Centre will provide an opportunity for agencies and the public to review and comment on the preferred design concept. Notices providing the date, time and location will be published in the local paper closer to the meeting date. Notices will also be mailed to those who have expressed an interest in being kept informed of the project.

You are encouraged to provide your input. Any comments received will be considered in the study. With the exception of personal information, all comments will become part of the Public Record and may be used in the Project File.

Northumberland County intends to proceed with the planning, design and construction of this project, to be completed by 2011, subject to comments received and the receipt of budget approval.
